



Monthly Summary for the Cabinet for June, 2019

Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month.

The important issues/developments related to the Department of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation during the month of June, 2019 are as under :-

A. Storage Position of Important Reservoirs-

Central Water Commission (CWC) is monitoring storage position of 91 important reservoirs spread all over the country. These include 37 reservoirs having significant hydro-power benefits with installed capacity of more than 60 MW each, out of which, 23 reservoirs have Storage build up less than or equal to average of previous 10 years. **Overall storage position in 91 reservoirs as on 27.06.2019 was 26.272 BCM, which is 89% of the storage of corresponding period of last year and 86% of the average storage of last 10 years.**

B. National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) –

The following are the achievements of Namami Gange in June, 2019 –

- Restoration of 3 ghats in Varanasi namely Janki Ghat, Anandmai Ghat and Chauki Ghat were completed in the Month of June, 2019.
- NMCG organized **International Yoga day** activities at Varanasi and RFD Patna from 17th – 21st June 2019 in which common people from all walks of life participated enthusiastically.
- On 3rd June 2019, NMCG along with Banaras Hindu University released a short documentary and theme song on Eco skilled training programme of Ganga Mitra under which 200 volunteers have been trained on different aspects of Ganga Rejuvenation.
- World Environment Day was celebrated by NMCG during a function organized on 5th June 2019. Awards were given to the winners of Ganga

G. 12th meeting of Expert Level Mechanism (JS level) between India & China for deliberation on cooperation of Transborder Cooperation on water resources was held at Ahmedabad from 12th -13th June, 2019.


